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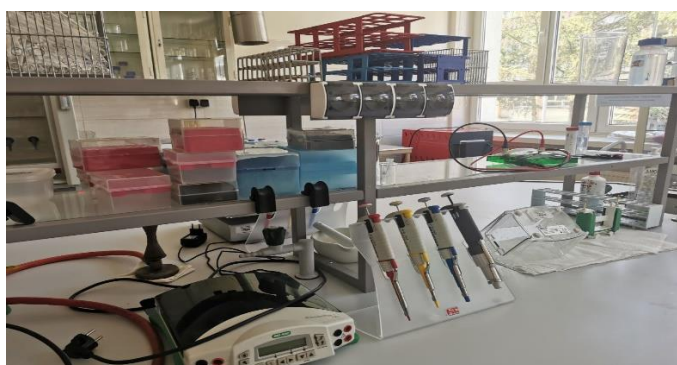

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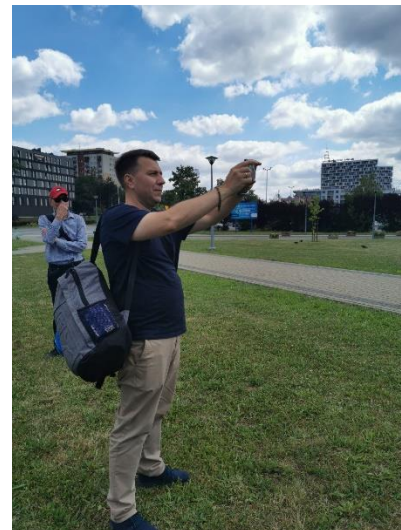
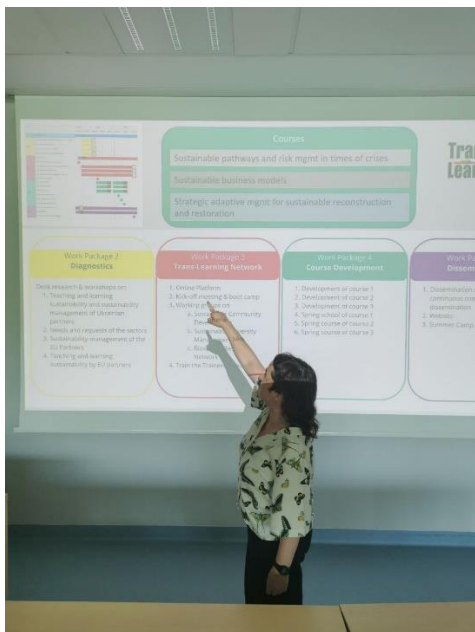

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Conservation Standards Training Course, University for sustainable development Eberswalde Brandenburg, Germany



The Open Standards for the Practice of Conservation, or Conservation Standards (CS) for short, are a widely adopted set of principles and practices that bring together common concepts, approaches, and terminology for conservation project design, management, and monitoring. Developed by the Conservation Measures Partnership (CMP) and regularly updated in collaboration with the broader community, this open-source, strategic process helps conservation teams achieve lasting impact. These efforts came together and led to the development of the Conservation Standards.



Yulia Nikitchenko, PhD in Economics, Associate Professor, leading specialist of the University of Sustainable Development Eberswalde, trainer on open standards, conducted a series of lectures on 'Conservation Standards' for working groups that work on the development of courses.



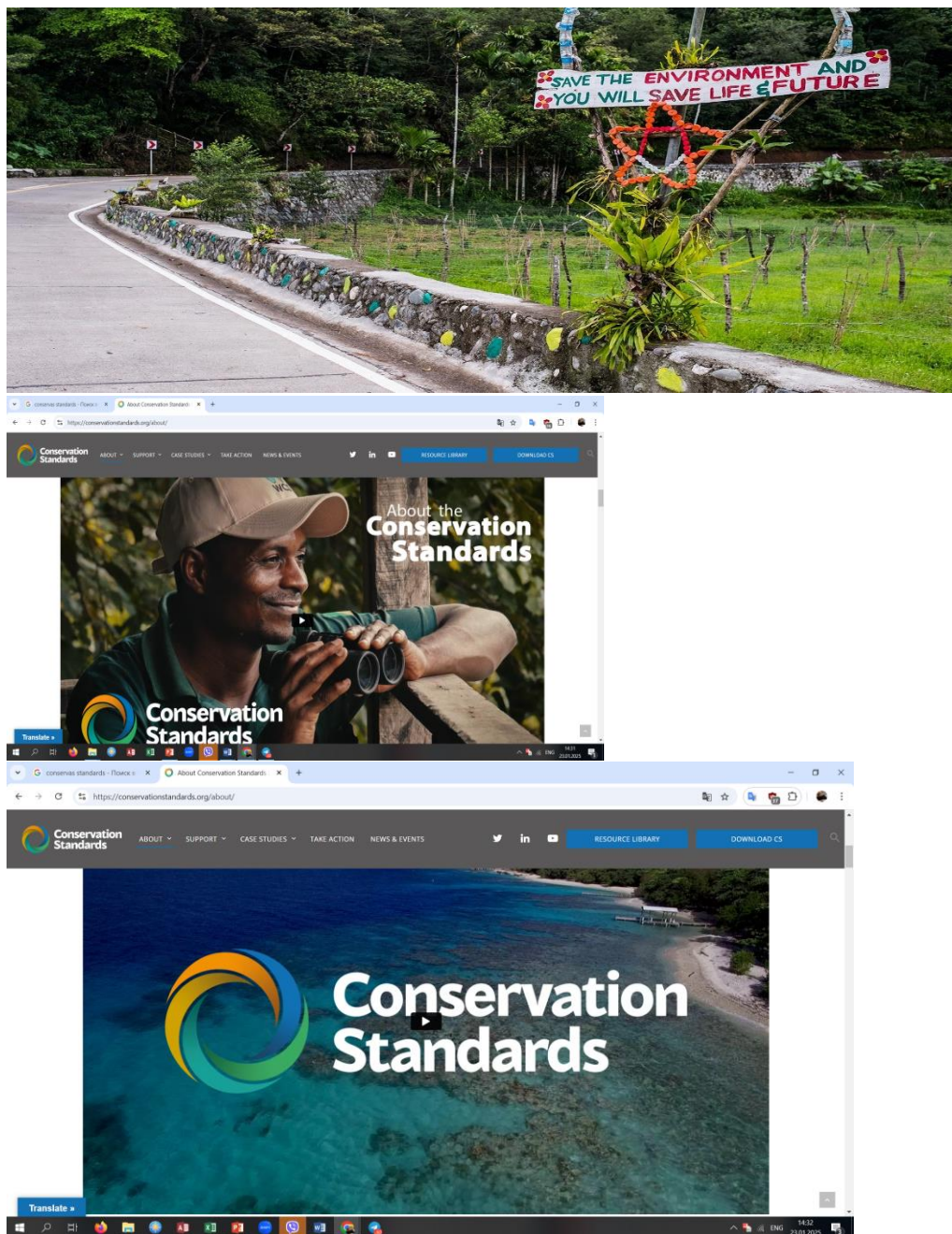

In order to check the adequacy of the course models being worked on by the partner universities of the TransLearning project consortium, during the training of trainers in Rzeszów it was proposed to develop roadmaps for the schools planned for spring-summer 2025 on the platforms of the European partner universities.
